Date: 07-04-2020

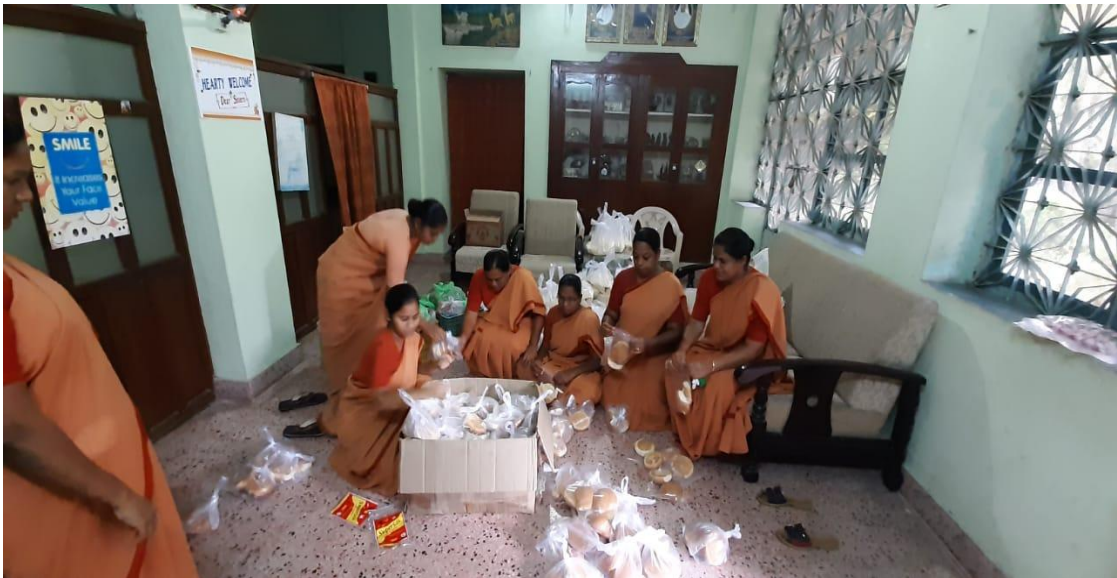
Distributed Rice, dall and oil to 300 families on 7th April, 2020 at Ithanagar and YedlaLingaya Colony, Tenali.
