Under the guidance of IQAC, the staff members conducted **Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS)** through Online Feedback Forms and the feedback was collated, analyzed and measures were taken. **All India Survey of Higher Education (AISHE)** was submitted on **10th January, 2020**.


UGC Expert Committee visited our college on **14th & 15th October, 2019** to evaluate the **Performance and Academic Attainments for the Extension of Autonomous Status**. And IQAC played a great role in preparation for grant of autonomous status to the college.



IQAC encouraged the staff and students to register for **online certificate courses** and many completed MOOCs and NPTEL online courses on various topics like Managing Online Classes and Co-creating MOOCs, Communicative English, Life Skills, Comprehensive e-learning to e-Training guide for Administrative Work, Human Growth and Development, Introduction to

Rings and Fields, Introduction to Abstract and Linear Algebra, Electromagnetism, Leadership, Gender Justice and Workplace Security, Life Skills, Data Base Management and so on for the academic year 2019-20.
