## **ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCESS**

Admission into the college is made strictly on the basis of merit with due consideration for the marginalized and weaker sections of society. The college reserves to itself the right of admission.

- ❖ Students who have passed 10+2 in relevant stream from a recognized board are eligible to join any UG level course.
- ❖ Admission to UG level programs is given on the basis of the applicant's merit in the qualifying examination.
- ❖ Those who have completed BSc, BA, B. Com Degree courses are considered eligible to join MSc, MA, and M. Com course respectively.
- ❖ Students are awarded scholarship by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Govt. of India and on merit basis depending upon their family's annual income.
- ❖ The Management provides Fee concessions to the economically backward students and merit scholarship to the bright poor and sports students
- ❖ The College authorities reserve the right to cancel the admission of a student without returning the fees if there be any discrepancy between the certificates produced and the entries made in the application

### **Admission Process**

- ❖ Students seeking admission to Degree & PG courses can view our college website in which we have displayed all the courses and Admission notice is given in the website every year.
- ❖ The first year students seeking admission must have passed in the two year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education Andhra Pradesh or any other examination conducted by any other Board/Institution recognised as equivalent.
- ❖ The students can obtain the Application and Prospectus from College office between 9:30 am to 5 pm.
- ❖ The eligible candidates can submit the application through post or in person
- ❖ Candidates provisionally selected for admission will be intimated by Post or through phone. They must present themselves for an interview with the Principal along with their Parents/Guardian on the date and the time mentioned in the card. At the time of interview, the student should produce required documents such as:
  - Marks memos of the qualifying examination
  - Transfer Certificate
  - Migration Certificate
  - Study Certificate
  - Conduct Certificate
  - Eligibility Certificate
  - Caste Certificate
  - Income Certificate
  - Recent Passport-size photograph

Students of different categories and communities are provided with different types of Scholarships depending upon their family income level. Following is the type of scholarship provided and the conditions on which it can be received.

S.No.	Type of Scholarship	Condition
1.	Govt. Of Andhra Pradesh	SC Students – Family Income should be less than 2,00,000/- ST/BC/EBC/DW – Family Income should be less than 100,000
2.	Govt.of India	Minority Students -Family Income should be less than 100,000
