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FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE OFFICE OF DEAN STUDENTS' WELFARE (2018-2023)

BUS PASS FACILITY

Bus pass facility to the students is monitored by Dean Students' Welfare. The office collects the forms from the students and submits them in the concerned office of Transport for preparation of passes and thereafter passes are distributed to the students. Students can get passes up to a distance of 50 KM.





MINI AUDITORIUM:

A Mini Auditorium is maintained for providing a venue for get-together and other programmes of students of the College. It is also provided to the students for such diverse programmes of discussions, Karate classes, Yoga classes and other cultural events etc. Other venues i.e. Centenary Auditorium, MBA Seminar Hall, IQAC Room etc. are also provided to the students, if need arises.



LUNCHEON KIOSK

A Luncheon Kiosk, established with contributions from the alumni of the Home Science Department, serves as a designated space for students to enjoy their lunch.







COMMON ROOM

The Girls' Common Room is a dedicated space designed to provide a comfortable and secure environment for female students. It is equipped with essential amenities, including seating arrangements, and a well-maintained washroom. The room also features a mirror, a dressing area, and adequate ventilation to ensure a pleasant atmosphere. A provision for clean drinking water and first –aid is available to cater to students' needs.

Additionally, the space serves as a relaxation zone where students can take short breaks, engage in discussions, or unwind during free periods. The provision of sanitary napkin vending machine and a disposal unit further ensures hygiene and convenience. Regular maintenance is carried out to keep the facilities in optimal condition, making the common room a supportive space for the well-being of the students.

The Common room is available for usage from 9:25 am to 5:30 pm except during the class hours unless permitted as per the need.







WAITING HALL

The Waiting Hall is a thoughtfully designed space that provides a comfortable environment for students and visitors. It is equipped with adequate seating arrangements to accommodate multiple individuals at a time. The hall is well-ventilated and features proper lighting to ensure a pleasant ambiance.

This facility serves multiple purposes, providing a convenient and comfortable space for visitors, including parents and guardians, who can wait during meetings, parent-teacher interactions, or other scheduled events, a resting area for students while waiting for their transportation or appointments. The space is regularly cleaned and maintained to uphold hygene and comfort.



MONITORING CO-CURRICULAR/EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Students are encouraged to participate in Academic, Sports and Cultural competitions organized by the concerned Committees and other institutions including University Youth Festivals and Sports Meets. In addition to their academic relevance, these extra and co-curricular activities develop leadership qualities, promote team work and develop an attitude of cooperation among students sensitizing them to appreciate other cultures, societies and languages. The office of DSW monitors the active participation of students in various Acade3mic, Sports and Cultural competitions organized outside the campus.

FACILITIES FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED STUDENTS

The office of the DSW is committed to creating an inclusive and accessible environment for differently abled students by providing the following facilities to ensure their comfort, convenience and equal opportunities:

- 1. **Accessible Ramps and Pathways:** Ramps with proper handrails are installed at all major entry points to ensure easy movement within the campus.
- 2. **Wheelchair Accessibility:** The campus is wheelchair-friendly, with wide pathways and designated spaces in classrooms and auditoriums.
- 3. **Accessible Restrooms:** Specially designed restrooms are available, equipped with grab bars and sufficient space for manoeuvring wheelchairs.

- 4. **Scribes and Assistance:** Scribes and additional time are provided during examinations, as per institutional policies and guidelines.
- 5. **Counselling Support:** Counselling services are available to address the emotional and academic needs of differently abled students.

These facilities are regularly reviewed and upgraded to ensure the campus remains inclusive and supportive for differently abled students.









GROUP INSURANCE SCHEME FOR STUDENTS

A Special Programme on health awareness and hygienic living was planned by the NSS Volunteers of our College.




