

We started from the college at 1.30pm to reach Poultry farm at Gudivada. Students observed cage system of poultry farming - layers .Single comb, white leghorn layers are rearing in the farm. 4 layers are kept in each cage. Cages are arranged in tiers in four sheds . Feed channel, egg receiving gutter and tap water system with nipple drinkers are provided. They got information about the management of rearing of layers like vaccines, deworming, debeaking, dubbing, egg laying capacity, culling, use of litter and excreta, marketing and economic importance. Cage system is very useful to recognize and isolate the infected fowls from other healthy fowls. The Manager explained about the composition of poultry feed and showed the preparation of their own poultry feed.

Then we proceeded to rearing of Broiler in deep litter system at Kopalle. The owner explained in detailed about the types of chick meal, timings, types of vaccines, precautions, deworming, debeaking, identification and isolation of infected birds, ventilation, maintenance of temperature and marketing. He also showed samples of vaccines with companies what they used.

Through this field trip, students came to know the management of poultry farm i.e. layers and broilers and gained practical experience.

A field trip is arranged to visit **Vamsikrishna fish breeding centre at Kuchipudi and Pedaravuru**. 56 students of III B.Sc C.B.Z and staff members of zoology departmentMrs.M.Aruna and Dr.P.Bujjamma visited the fish breeding centre from 12.30 to 3.30p.m.

The technician i.eMr.Gopi explained about cement hatcheries, Chinese hatcheries, Jar hatcheries, and breeder tank and nursery ponds. As it is breeding season of Indian major carps, the pituitary hormone injection is given to induce breeding in Catla and Rohu. They observed the process of induced breeding inCatla. Spawn is collected from breeder tank & kept in Chinese hatcheries for 3 days. Next fry is collected from hatcheries and kept in nursery ponds for further growth of fingerlings. This is collected and measured in measuring cups. Then seed is kept in polythene bags containing 2/3 of transport medium and 1/3 of oxygen. The seed containers are filled with oxygen and transported to fish rearing ponds. Rearing ponds are prepared for acclimatization of fish seed with removal of aquatic weeds and netting of predators. Students estimated the PH value, Temperature, collection of plankton and also collected the sample for the estimation of oxygen.

Out come: The field trip helped the students to have practical experience. Whatever they learned in the class room, they observed it in the field itself. It also encourages the students to realize the importance of self-employment.





Students gained the knowledge about Structure and functions of major histocompatibility complexes and Cytokines and practical experience.


