9. Either institution shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 60 days' prior written notice to the other institution.

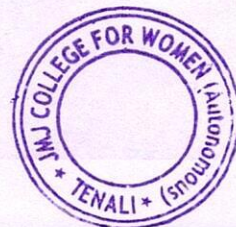
C) CONFIDENTIALITY
