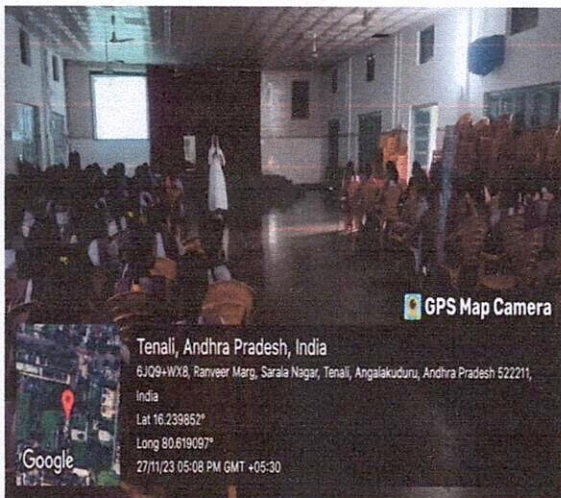
REPORT 2022-2023

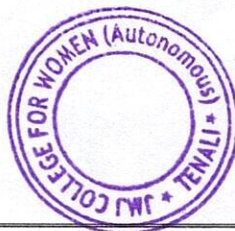



In accordance with UGC Regulations (vide No.F.1-16/2009 (CPP-II) dated 21.10.2009) and the Andhra Pradesh Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 (Act No. 26 of 1997) [21st August, 1997], we are committed to curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions.

ANTI - RAGGING

Ragging is defined as any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act that involves teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness any other student. It includes indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities likely to cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm, or to raise fear or apprehension in a fresher or any other student. Additionally, it encompasses asking students to perform acts outside the ordinary course, causing a sense of shame or embarrassment that adversely affects the physique or psyche of a fresher or any other student.

CONSEQUENCES FOR RAGGING:

Individuals found guilty may face one or more of the following punishments, depending on the nature and severity of the offense;

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
3. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
4. Withholding of Results.
5. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
6. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
7. Cancellation of admission.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

All students are strictly warned not to engage in any form of indiscipline, misconduct, or acts that may be construed as ragging.

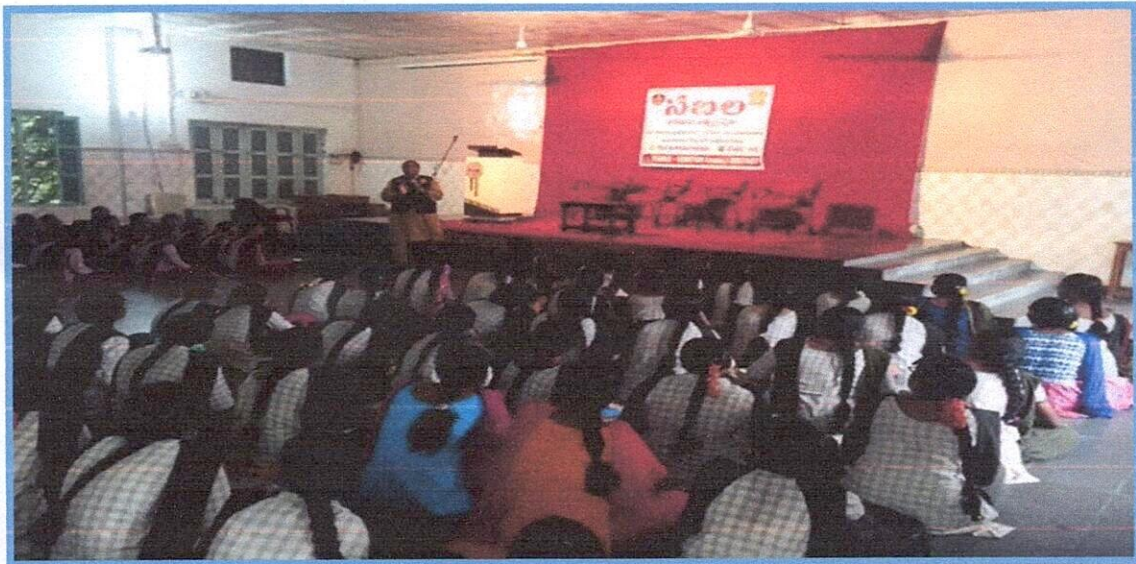

Outcome: The I Degree students became familiar with the Women Empowerment Cell objectives and its activities in and surrounding village women of JMJ College.

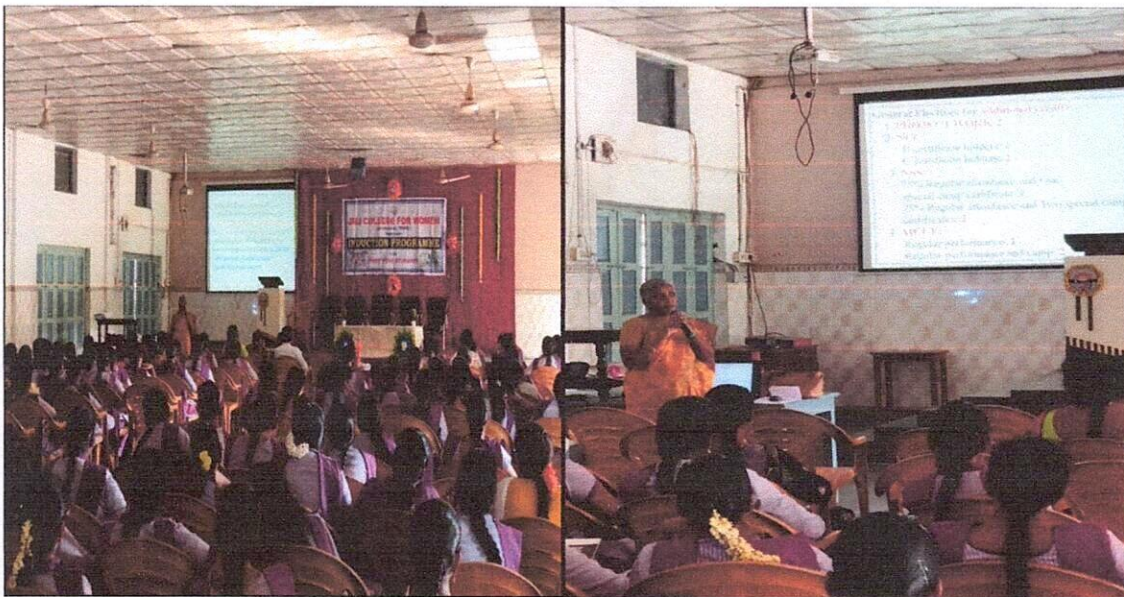

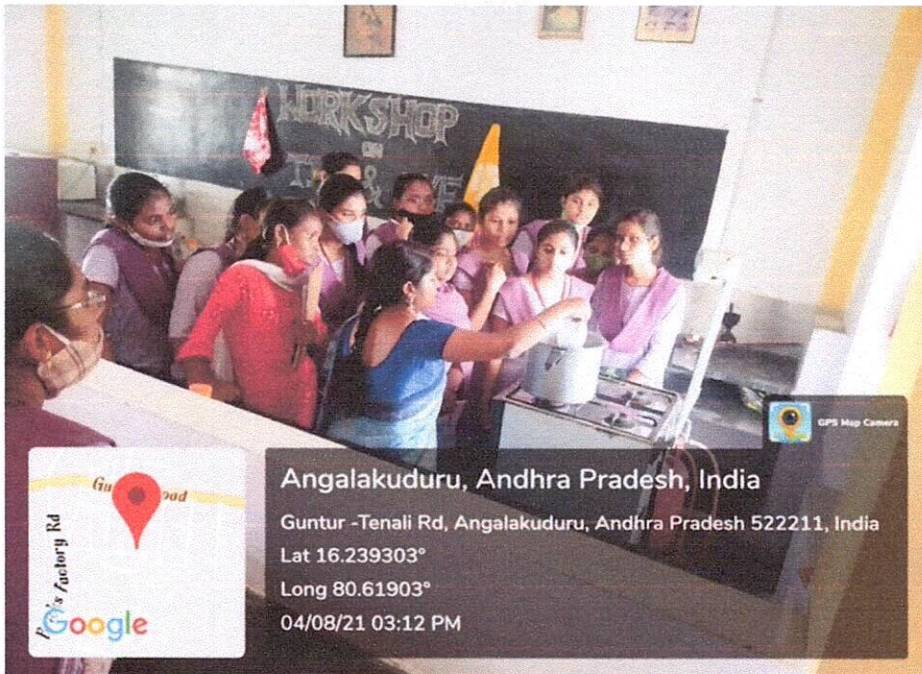

"A penny saved is a penny earned", is an old saying. In India, almost everything is used and reused. An attractive garment made at little or no cost will help to adjust clothing allowance so that money can be saved for better quality in some other garments, or money for some other purpose. Remaking a garment is a greater challenge to a girl's ability and workmanship than making a garment of new material. Made-over or remodelled garments may be as attractive as new ones. If the entire garment is re-cut, it is considered as remaking, or restyling. If only some part of the garment is changed as neck, sleeves or hem, it is a remodelling problem. Alongside, this has an important social impact — this work gives employment to women who can then employ others.

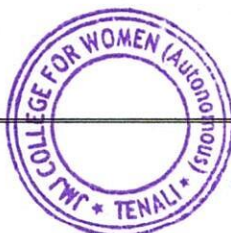

Resource Person 1, Shri. Vasireddy Padma, Chairperson, AP Women’s Commission. She stressed that Reproductive health care is life cycle approach and the Primary Health Centres should focus on these issues. We need proper supervision and monitoring authorities to identify the loopholes in the system and to rectify those.

Resource Person 2, Dr. Sr. Shiny .K .P presented a few insights on the topic of the webinar Reproductive Choice of Woman is a Fundamental Right encompassed under the umbrella of Article 21 of the Constitution of India. She felt that need to put a lot of effort to bring awareness among women about their fundamental right in this patriarchal society where male mostly takes the advantage of making decisions in the family.

Resource Person 3, Dr. K. R. R. Madhuri highlighted the topic Do Reproductive Rights merely mean the Right to Reproduce? Or is the inextricably linked to the numerous questions that surround women’s reproductive freedom. She felt that the ability to reproduce seems to be what that sets women apart from men but women actually does not have the freedom to choose whether, when and how many children to have.

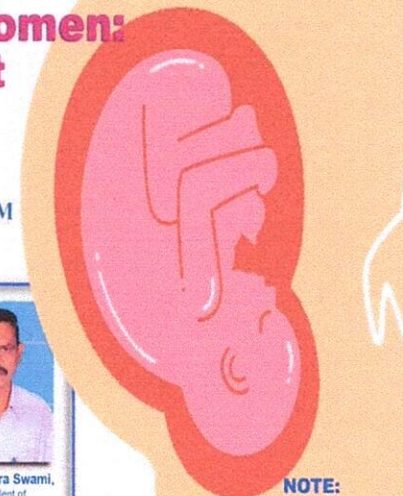

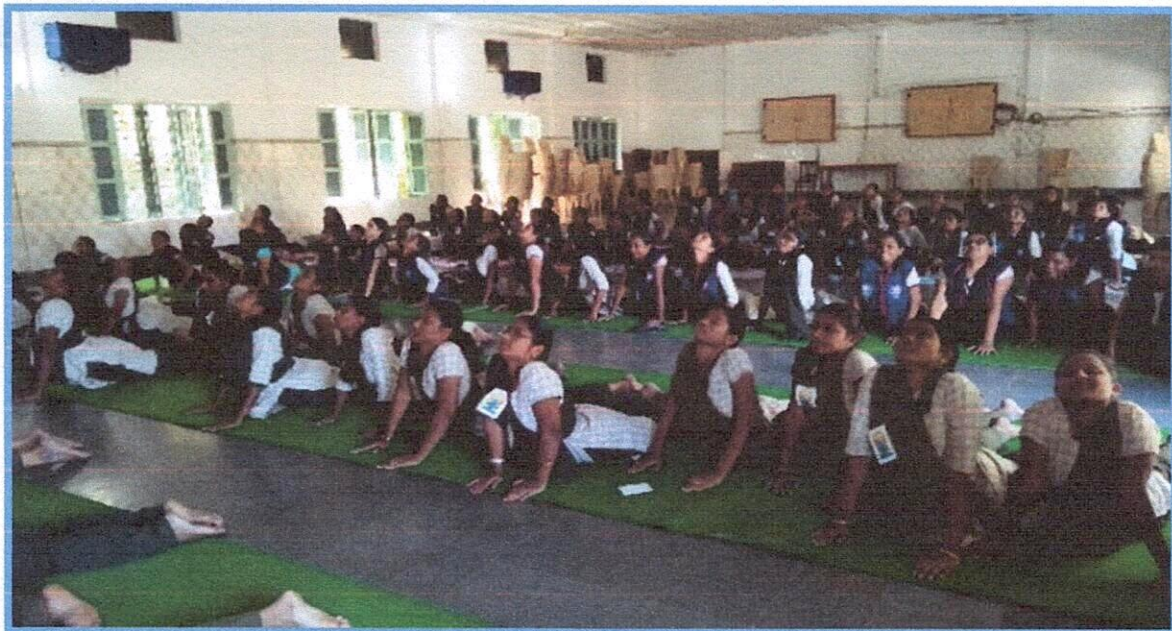

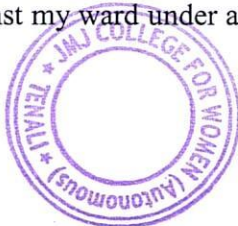
