INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

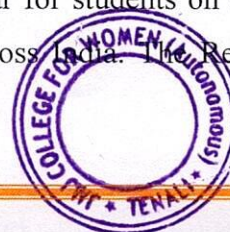
The activities planned by the Departments and Committees were carried out for the year 2021-22. The college received Good Hygiene Practices certifications from HYM International certifications Pvt Ltd, Hyderabad on 28th July 2021 under the guidance of IQAC.

The College received ISO 50001:2011 Certification from HYM, Hyderabad for the Implementation of Energy Saving Practices on 10th November, 2021 and also received ISO 14001:2015 Certification from HYM, Hyderabad for the Implementation of Greenery and Environmental Promotion Activities on 9th November, 2021. Our college was ranked 122nd in India and 19th in Andhra Pradesh among India's Best Private Autonomous Colleges, as per ranking announced by Education World India Autonomous Colleges Rankings 2021-22. **Multipurpose Gymnasium was constructed with grants from the UGC during the XI Plan and it was inaugurated on 3rd January 2022.**

IQAC ensured timely preparation and release of college academic calendar for the year 2021-2022 by taking inputs from Governing Board, Academic Council Principal, Departments, Committees, Cells, Clubs and Controller of Examinations. Faculties and students undertook several MOOC Courses on Cultural Tourism in India, Concepts of C-Programming, Life Skills, **Introduction** to Computer Science, and **Environmental** Economics offered by SWAYAM- NPTEL and ANU online platforms. IQAC organized one week Student Induction Programme for the First Year Undergraduate students.

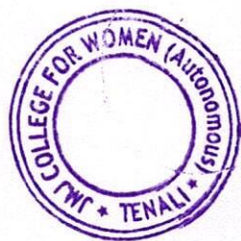

The AQAR was presented before the Academic Council for the approval and it was submitted online in the NAAC portal. The College participated in the NIRF ranking 2022. The IQAC collected the data as per the NIRF Ranking Parameters and submitted the data. Annual data collection and submission to the online portal of All India Survey on Higher education (AISHE) for the academic year was successfully completed by IQAC and the data submitted was approved by AISHE. Under the guidance of IQAC, all departments conducted their respective **Boards of Studies** meetings followed by **Academic Council meeting** and **Autonomous Governing Board meeting**. Time tables for Semester and Examinations and Practical examinations were chalked out by IQAC. Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) i.e. feedback on faculty was taken from all the students and on various aspects of the administration to improve the quality of the institution. The collected data was analyzed and measures were taken for the further improvement of the college. IQAC recommended research promotion initiatives such as providing maximum Rs.10,000 to the staff to carry out research projects and other research works. More than 20 teaching staff utilized seed money for their research works.
